- One (1) professional letter of recommendation signed with a wet or typed signature on **letterhead**. One (1) Scholarship Reference Form completed by a **high school guidance counselor** signed with a wet or typed signature.
- A two minute video response to a personal statement prompt question AND a 500-word response to one of the essay questions.
- Your Biography (250 words or less) that will be read at the Scholarship Reception if notified as a winner.
- A 4x6 headshot of yourself with your name included on the back of the picture. Please note submission of the headshot gives Education Over Debt Foundation permission to use for promotional purposes.
- Please DO NOT staple pages submitted for review and DO Not send screenshots..

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**Mission**

Education Over Debt Foundation mission is to provide scholarships to African American high school students in North Carolina attending a four-year College and University, Historically Black College and University (HBCU), and undocumented high school students of color in North Carolina on the path to citizenship attending a two-year or four-year College and University. The Foundation delivers value to the community by emphasizing training on money management, wealth accumulation techniques, and wellness to enhance financial literacy while also mentoring students during their college journey.

The Education Over Debt podcast provides practical financial tips that anyone can understand and implement today. Episodes are located on the Education Over Debt page on YouTube with guests sharing their money story and tips for students as they prepare for college and adulthood.

**Award Description**

The recipients of this scholarship will receive a \$2,000 Award; this award is non-renewable and is awarded to one student, a male or female, for undergraduate study at a four-year degree granting accredited HBCU within the United States.

**Eligibility**

Eligibility for the EOD Scholarship Program is open provided the following criteria is met:

*Complete This Application ONLY if you are:*

- A permanent resident of North Carolina. Your parent/guardian must also reside in North Carolina upon your entrance into college.
  
- An African-American student graduating high school with at least a C average (GPA-2.5/4.0 or 3.5/5.0) You must be attending a four-year accredited HBCU within the United States for the Fall semester of the 2024 school year.
  
- Copy of a college acceptance letter showing acceptance into a four-year degree granting Historically Black College or University (HBCU) in the United States by April 1, 2024.
  
- Not a relative [by virtue of blood, marriage or generational relations] to a member of the Board of Directors of the Education Over Debt Foundation.
